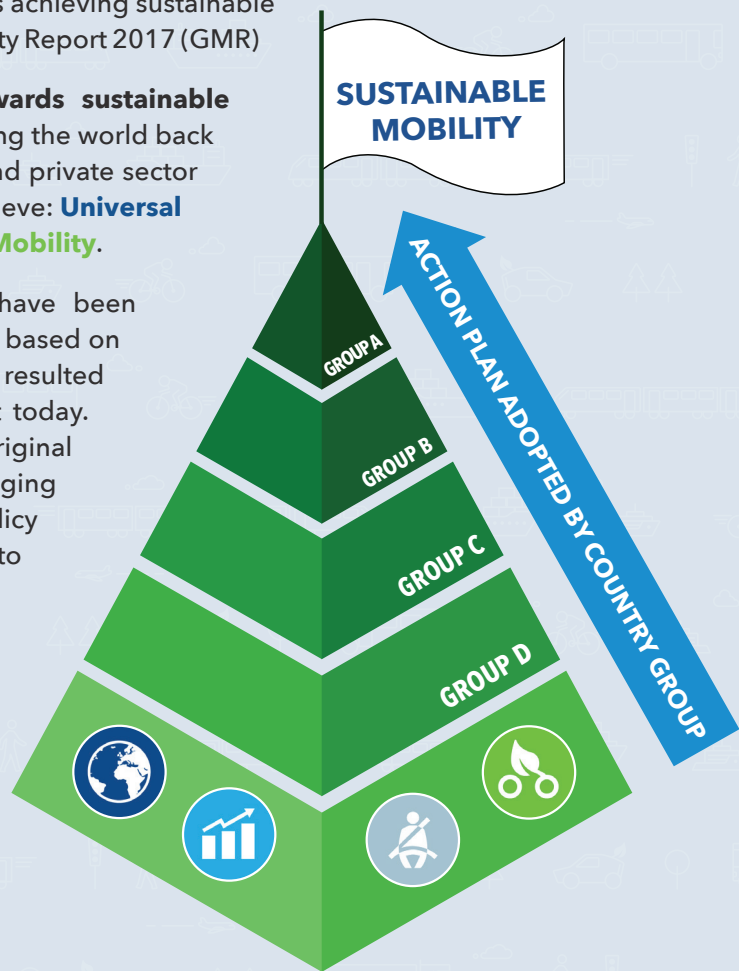
SUSTAINABLE mobility™ FOR ALL

“The transport sector is off-track towards achieving sustainable mobility,” according to the Global Mobility Report 2017 (GMR)

The **Global Roadmap of Action towards sustainable mobility (GRA)** will focus on **how** to bring the world back on track. It identifies policy measures and private sector actions that are most appropriate to achieve: **Universal Access**; **Efficiency**; **Safety**; and **Green Mobility**.

Too often in the past, action plans have been devised with one policy goal in mind or based on a “one-size-fits-all” approach: this has resulted in the state of transport as we know it today. The GRA aims to provide a true and original contribution to the mobility debate, bringing a new perspective by looking across policy goals and tailoring policy actions to country circumstances.

The GRA is being developed in an iterative process to ensure its relevance for decision makers. All interested parties - countries, cities, private sector and other relevant stakeholders have been invited to share their ideas on how to transform the global mobility system.



The GRA is produced by the **Sustainable Mobility for All (SuM4All) initiative**, a growing global coalition of over 50 leading actors in the transport and mobility space with a shared vision to transform the future of mobility.
